

**MEADOWBROOK PARK**  
**Historic Redwood Ballroom**  
**Alcohol Guide**

**(FORM 3A)**

Meadowbrook Park leases the Historic Redwood Ballroom for Wedding Receptions with the understanding that the total guest list shall not exceed 600 guests for a five hour event. You are reminded that you as the Lessee have assumed the Liquor liability for the event by signing the rental contract.

Meadowbrook has a very liberal alcohol policy in that it is based on the amount of alcohol that can be safely consumed by a mixed crowd of men and women during a five hour period and be able to absorb the alcohol by the time they leave the building, providing they drink in moderation and not to excess. The alcohol limits are do not take into consideration that many of the 600 guests are underage and cannot consume alcoholic beverages. This means that to number of 12 ounce beers available to an adult in attendance is more than the 4 ½ - 12 ounce glasses that is used to figure the total.

Measures used for calculation of alcohol limits

A case of beer is defined as 24 – 12 ounce cans of beer.

One 12 ounce glass/can of beer is equal to 1 mixed drink containing a 1.5 ounce “shot” of liquor

One 12 ounce glass/can of beer is equal to one 5 ounce glass of wine.

The Daiquiri Machine usually has 50 – 5 ounce drinks with 1 “shot” of alcohol in each drink  
One batch is the equivalent of 50 -12 ounce glasses/cans of beer.

1/5 of liquor is 25.6 ounces – also a 750 ml bottle and this equals 17 - 12 ounce glasses/cans of beer

1 liter of liquor is 32 ounces and this equals 21 – 12 ounce glasses/cans of beer

½ gallon of liquor is 64 ounces or 1.89 liters and this equals 43 – 12 ounce glasses/cans of beer

1 gallon of liquor is 128 ounces or 3.8 liters and this equals 85 – 12 ounce glasses/cans of beer
